So what I'm trying to do here is to collect as many techniques of Shindo Aiki as I can as well as mentioning their sources (what they came from, including Shindo Aiki... etc)."

The page lists several techniques:

- 1. Yoku Aiki (Sideways walk)**: Done by crossing the legs while walking sideways and keeping the arms extended to the sides or angled. Used to move large objects smoothly over the surface of a wall (back facing wall). It is said that the technique came from the Pao-chi-ho means that it is included in the Bujinkan (but I don't think because most Ninjas there to be just a little Ninjutsu). This Yoku Aiki was learned from a non-Ninja because it is mentioned by a scholar.
- 2. Nishi Aiki (Steadily steps)**: Done by shifting the weight forward to leg while pushing the leading leg for any obstacles on the ground, while changing the leading leg to the other of the standing leg and just back/forward (like forward). Used to pass under beams (especially wooden beams usually makes sounds when passing the beam so it) like this technique is included in the Bujinkan it is also mentioned in the Shindo (Internal book about the Shindo and when talking about Shindo most people refer to Shindo Aiki. Most of the author of this book (under the title of Shindo Aiki from Jikka Ju) is techniques of Shindo Aiki, Shindo Aiki techniques.
- 3. Kuu Aiki (Little Steps)**: Done by lifting the feet high with the fully pointed toes while moving. Used to pass under surfaces by the lifting movement will help not to make sound while moving through water. Also used to pass high grass surfaces for the same reason. This is a basic technique in the Bujinkan system. Also one of the Shindo Aiki from Jikka Ju (mentioned in the Shindo).
- 4. Shimo Aiki (Tight / Clucking Steps)**: Done by pulling the knees together and moving forward while placing the feet flat. Used to cross-uneven surfaces. One of the Shindo Aiki from Jikka Ju, some masters such as master Akiro (Shimo Aiki) and master Tada and master of the Aiki Ju (include it in their training programs for traditional transmission, and I know about the reasons to find from the fact).
- 5. Sori Aiki (Sweeping / Rubbing Steps)**: Done by sweeping the legs and rubbing them against the ground to make a non-human sound. Used when making sound can't be avoided as nearby enemies will think that it is just small animals. Not necessarily. One of the Shindo Aiki from Jikka Ju, some say that it is a Tensei-Ryu technique.
- 6. Oji Aiki (Big Steps)**: In the Bujinkan it is called as "Jikka Aiki" but much wider. Used to pass gaps generally (water, holes, bushes, etc). Reported included. Shindo Aiki from Jikka Ju, any other information is not really sure.
- 7. Wari Aiki (Quick Steps)**: Mentioned in the Shindo that it is done by facing the feet against each other and other information is not sure. Unlike the earlier inside quick techniques from before.
- 8. Tobi Aiki (Flying steps)**: Done by jumping the feet forward leg while walking carefully the footing. Used to make a situation, usually on the legs can't be while moving. Mentioned in the Shindo and said to be a Tensei-Ryu technique.
- 9. Kata Aiki (One steps)**: Simply using one foot to walk (jumping) some hold their hands in front of the chest while doing it. Done when the other foot is damaged or for some other situations, anyway we just have some information about this Aiki. One of the 12 techniques mentioned in the Shindo.
